Notice of Race

Event: Nordic Championship 11:metre One Design

Combined Nordic- and Swedish Championship H-Boat

Date: 13-15/9, 2019

Organizer: Gränna BK

1 Rules

1.1 The regatta will be governed by the rules as defined in the Racing Rules of Sailing (RRS) and with appendix S.

The sailing instructions will consist of the instructions in RRS Appendix S, Standard Sailing Instructions, and supplementary sailing instructions that will be handed out at registration, and published on the official notice board located at the website Official Notice Board, (https://sites.google.com/site/klassforbundetsvenska11/nordic-championship).

1.2 The 11:metre One Design Class Rules will apply for the 11:metre class, except for 7.3.1. There will not be any weight in prior to the regatta.

The H-Boat Class Rules will apply for the H-Boat Class. The weight of each crew will be measured prior to the regatta. Maximum weight of the crew is 300 kg.

- 1.3 The competitor that is in charge on board, shall follow Swedish Sailing Federations racing license regulation for competitors. This regulation applies from the year the competitor reach the age of 13. Competitors from other countries than Sweden are exempt from this regulation.
- 1.4 Competitors shall when afloat wear personal flotation devices. This rule does not apply to short-term replacement or adjustment of clothing or personal equipment, or when competitors are in the harbour or under deck. Wet suits and dry suits are not personal flotation devices. This changes RRS 40. A boat that breaks this rule may be warned or penalized at the discretion of the protest committee.

2 Eligibility requirements

2.1 For the 11:metre class:

Competitors shall comply with World Sailing Regulation 19.

For the H-Boat Class:

To be entitled to participate in Riksidrottsförbundets championships, each competitor must comply with World Sailing Regulation 19.

In order to be awarded the title Swedish Champion (SM) the competitors shall be Swedish citizens or have resided in Sweden for at least six months the last twelve months before the regatta starts.

At championships with more than one competitor per boat, a majority of the crew (more than 50%) shall comply with the rule regarding the title Swedish Champion. If so, the entire crew will be awarded the title Swedish Champion.

2.2 Each participating boat shall be insured with a valid third party liability insurance.

2.3 Competitors participate in the regatta entirely at their own risk. See RRS 4, Decision to Race. The organising authority will not accept any liability for material damage or personal injury or death sustained in conjunction with or prior to, during, or after the regatta.

3 Entries

- 3.1 Entry shall be made not later than September 8, 2019.

- 3.2 The entry fee is 2 500 SEK and shall be paid to Gränna BK, via Sailarena.
- 3.3 Late entry is possible with additional fee of 500 SEK and shall be paid to Gränna BK not later than September 14, 2019, via Sailarena.
- 3.4 Out of the entry fee in the 11:metre fleet, 200 SEK will go to the Swedish 11:metre Class Organization, and out of the entry fee in the H-Boat fleet 200 SEK will go to the Swedish H-Boat Class Organization.
- 3.5 The entry fee includes the cost of lifting boats in- and out of the water one time each.

4. Registration and measurement checks

- 4.1 Registrations shall be made at the race office not later than September 14, 2019, 09:00.
- 4.2 Measurement certificates shall be presented prior to racing.
- 4.3 A boat or equipment may be inspected at any time for compliance with the class rules and sailing instructions. On the water, the race- or/and the technical committee can instruct a boat to proceed immediately to a prescribed location for inspection.
- 4.4 Substitution of damaged or lost equipment will not be allowed unless approved by the Race Committee. Requests for substitution shall be made to the Race Committee at the first reasonable opportunity.
- 4.5 A competitor may not be substituted without the written permission of the Race Committee.

5 Time Schedule

5.1 Registration:

Friday 13/9: 19.00-20.00 Saturday 14/9: 08.00-09.00

5.2 Dates of racing:

Saturday 14/9 Sunday 15/9

5.3 Number of races

8 races are scheduled.

5.4 The scheduled time of the warning signal for each day is:

Saturday 14/9: 10.00 Sunday 15/9: 09.00

5.5 On the last scheduled day of racing no warning signal will be made after 13.00.

6. Racing area

6.1 The racing areas will be on the lake Vättern outside Gränna.

7. The course

7.1 The course to be sailed will be a windward-leeward course.

8. Protests and punishment

8.1 RRS Appendix T1 will apply.

9. Scoring

- 9.1 The low point scoring system of RRS Appendix A will apply, modified so that when three or fewer races have been completed, a boat's series score will be the total of her race scores.
- 9.2 3 races are required to be completed to constitute a championship.

10. Prizes

- 10.1 Prizes will be awarded to at least the top 3 boats in each class.
- 10.2 For the H-Boat Class and Swedish Championship (SM):
 Championship plaquettes and titles may be awarded if six or more boats from at least three different Swedish clubs located in more than one Swedish district have crossed the finish line in one race in the championship.
